This is the time signature
- it tells you to count four
beats in each bar

This sign tells you to
repeat from where the sign
is round the opposite way -
in this case, the beginning!

The tune is written in tablature. The lines that go across the page are the strings. I have labelled them at the beginning of the tablature. The small numbers on the strings are the notes that you play. The very first note of the tune is an open e string (0 = open!). The next note is the 5th fret of the e string (5e on your EZ-fret kit!). Carry on across the page and then drop down to the next "bank" of tablature reading and playing the notes as they appear from left to right. The vertical lines that you can see underneath the notes are the timing strokes - don't worry if you can't understand these. It's probably easier to follow the counting that I have typed on top of the notes. When you get to the end, repeat the tune.
