


Navigating a Document on a Phone or Tablet

When viewing a document / internet page on a phone or tablet, you may wonder how to perform the Find operation without a keyboard.


The answer is simple and will depend on which internet browser you are using. Here are two examples.

In Chrome:

Open the page/document you wish to navigate. Here I am opening a PDF document and wish to search for key phrases:




Click on the 3 dots to the right hand side of the browser bar: A menu will appear and you can scroll down to "Find in page". A search bar will appear and you can type in the key word you are looking for. Note the up and down arrows to the right - this allows you to scroll through the document/page to find all the occurrences.



In Safari

Navigate to the page/document you want to search. Underneath the browser bar you will see the share button. (Box with an arrow).



Sharing options will then come up e.g. share to message, WhatsApp, Airdrop etc. Sorry, I have had to block out friends for the sake of privacy! **Scroll down on all those options** until you come to "Find on Page" You now have the search bar and up and down arrows!
