ERRATUM:

At 4:31 I say that you have to hold the PTN key down to call up the various patterns and banks.

You don't!!

If the PTN key is lit, just use the left and right arrow keys to access the various banks and then just press the appropriate key to select the pattern. Thereafter, just re-press the PTN key to choose other banks/patterns

Please make use of the chapter markers!

Please note at around [8:46](#), when I talk about pressing down on the E encoder to change the order of the notes in the chord - it doesn't actually change the notes of the chord, only the way they appear in the stack.

You will see that E5 becomes A4 - sorry, you don't actually see me pressing the E encoder down!

C5	E5
A4	C5

If I were to change the TIME of these notes i.e. when they sound in the bar - then you would hear a difference.
