VIDEO 2 - GETTING STARTED/FIRST RECORDING CONTENTS

In this video I show you how to make a simple multi-track recording with an acoustic guitar and then I mix it and add some fx. Please use the chapter markers that I have provided.

This is a great machine to use - I'm loving it!! 😊

btw - when I talk about the compressor towards the end of the video - there is a Master Compressor and an individual compressor for each track.

Erratum - I have just spoken to the inventor who has kindly picked me up on a few things:

- Input keyboard: You can double tap on SHIFT to enable CapsLock, single tap disables CapsLock again
- Overdub: You can also quickly enable/disable Overdub by touching the OVR Text on the Audio Overview bottom left
- Record Offset: This moves the recorded audio to the left. This is especially useful if you record a Drum Machine that has a known constant Latency.
- Redo: This only has an effect when Redo lights up - after Undo.
- TrackFX: You don't need to hold the Track Button. SHIFT+FX always takes you to the selected Tracks FX (the track that's displayed green in AudioOverview). Inside TrackFX you can quickly switch tracks by pressing SHIFT+TrackButton
