

All The Sharps - air tapping!

Play all 2nd fret e string notes with index finger of left hand

Play all other notes with index finger of right hand

Please note: all notes sound as a result of tapping the string down onto the fretboard (hammering on) and not by plucking the string!!

Hold the guitar flat across your lap -

try raising your left leg with something (a foot stool?)

Advanced technique: notes marked with * can be played by holding the index finger of the left hand behind the 2nd fret of the e string and pulling off the index finger of the right hand once the higher note on the e string has been tapped

All of these notes are sharps (black notes on a piano keyboard)

The tune is in the key of F sharp major

These are the notes you play in this tune:-

2e = F sharp - this is the note that is played before and after every other note except for the last.

6e = A sharp

4e = G sharp

4B = D sharp

6G = C sharp

3G = A sharp

6D = G sharp

4D = F sharp

Please note that this tune is usually played for fun on the piano in a very similar way - playing the F sharp above Middle C with the index finger of the left hand and all other notes above and below this note with the index finger of the right hand "crossing" hands in the process.
