

Happy – Pharrell Williams (1 of 2)

(Easy guitar version for young guitarists)

Watch the You Tube Video!!

Go to "greenplectrumfilms"

Capo on 1st fret – tuning will be as follows:

1st = F (highest sounding string)

2nd = C

3rd = G# or Ab

4th = D# or Eb

5th = A# or Bb

6th = F

My code:-

0e = open highest pitched E string/

1G = 1st fret of the G string/

2A = 2nd fret of the A string/

0E = open lowest pitched E string (thickest!!)
etc.

Intro:-

E7 0e five downstrums (or play 0E 5 times)
0B
1G
0D
2A
0E

Verse Riff – (remember that you have a capo on the 1st fret so when I say 3rd fret, it's really the 4th fret!!)

(play in the gap after each line of singing)

0E 3E (0E) 0A 3E 2A 0A 3E 0A 3E 0E*

Happy – Pharrell Williams (2 of 2)

This riff is played 4 times but don't play 0E* on the end of the 4th time. The (0E) is optional – leave this out if you find it too hard to squeeze in!

Chorus Chords

Cmaj7 0e
0B
0G
2D
3A

Bm 2e
3B
4G

E7 (see 1st page!)

This is what you actually play on the chorus:-

"1 2 3 4 and 1 2 3 4 1 2 3 4 and 1 2 3 4"
Cmaj7 Bm Bm E7

Use single strums – the Cmaj7 and the 2nd Bm are on the beat. The 1st Bm and the E7 are off the beat.

The sequence is played four times.

Repeat Verse/Chorus

Middle Section – "Bring me down" – play nothing!!

Double Chorus – play sequence of chords eight times.

2nd Middle Section – half the length of the 1st middle section – play nothing!!

Double Chorus – play sequence of chords eight times.
