

## NEPTUNE

- 1) The Leaving – Neptune’s crew bid their families farewell. The voyage awaits.....destination, the planet Neptune.
- 2) Heading Out – Neptune heads out into deep space – Earth is left far behind.
- 3) Lost – The ship’s guidance computer malfunctions.....
- 4) Can You Hear Me? – Neptune’s commander tries in vain to contact Earth.
- 5) Battle – As the ship nears a strange green planet it is suddenly engaged in a ferocious battle with an alien cruiser piloted by two-headed females.
- 6) Moon – After successfully destroying the cruiser, Neptune is strangely drawn to the moon of the green planet by the “singing” of its female inhabitants – an unearthly yet hypnotic sound that suddenly fills the ship’s speaker system.
- 7) The Chase – Neptune’s commander, suddenly realising what is happening, puts the ship into full thrust to escape the “magnetic” pull of the moon. The aliens give chase.
- 8) Coming Home – Neptune manages to shake off the aliens. Having wasted so much fuel in the battle and in the subsequent flight the commander has no choice but to return to Earth as best he can using the stars for guidance.
- 9) Goodbye – Three weeks go by. Air, food and water are all but gone. The crew say goodbye to each other and record video messages for their loved ones in the hope that one day the Neptune will be discovered by another ship from Earth.
