

## DAY TRIPPER (The Beatles)

*Check out the original on "The Beatles – Past Masters – Volume Two"*

### *Simple note code*

*The counting is on top. I have underlined the counting where the notes occur.*

*The small numbers underneath the coded notes are your left hand fingers (if you are right-handed!)*

*The first riff is based on an E major chord and uses three strings - E,A and D*

*The riff then moves over onto the A, D and G strings – all the frets and fingers are the same. This riff is based on an A major chord.*
